My, how things change with time! In November 2000, I ran an article in the Sierra-Diablo Matchcover Club Bulletin on Minor Politicals...And I was lamenting what a mess it was to try and organize them coherently. Some years before, I had written a smaller piece about what a lackluster category Minor Politicals was and how I had no use for them, whatsoever. I ended that earlier summation with an offer, I believe, to give those I happened to have to somebody...anybody...who wanted them. I ended up giving them to Stan Tombs, if I remember correctly.

Well, now I collect them! [Actually, I beginning to believe that, given enough time, I'll end up collecting everything!] Anyway, now I had to deal with organizing them. It was challenging, to say the least. You can't organize them by the candidate's last name, because there are more than a few that don't have any names. You can organize them by state and/or city...because most don't have that! By dates? Nope! Most aren't dated. By political party? Most don't indicate a party affiliation. Boy, that doesn't leave much!

So, what I settled on is the *office* the candidate is running for. Now, right off the bat, there are still some covers that aren't going to have that, either (see the office listing below), but they're few. Thus, my Political albums are organized by office, and then by size within each office, and finally alphabetically within each size. Here are the offices I have so far:
