




Well, I hardly know where to begin! I'll no doubt end up inadvertently slighting a few collectors here,

They're not fancy or particularly colorful. Indeed, as covers go, they're almost singularly indistinctive and unattractive.

Just look at these representative samples. Who collects Rock Products, Refrigerants, and Carbon Products? Or, what about Machinery Companies, Galvanized Siding, and Paper Products? Even if you lump them altogether under, say, "Industrial Covers", how many people collect that?
