Of course, with regard to your own collection, *you* always have the final say as to what the collecting guidelines are...but....if you *do* count these as different covers...where do you draw the line?

Are they different if the manumark is the same, but with different locations? How about all those Universal covers with the1, 2, or 3 dots on either side of the manumark? Is the 2-dot cover a different cover from the 3-dot cover? What is the manumark text is the same, but different colors? Different sizes?

It's a perplexing problem. Personally, I don't count them as different covers, but that's just me.
