Tysons Corner's *USA Today*

USA Today is a national American daily newspaper published by the Gannett Company. It was founded by Al Neuharth. The newspaper vies with *The Wall Street Journal* for the position of having the widest circulation of any newspaper in the United States, something it previously held since 2003. According to the Audit Bureau of Circulations, the paper has 1.8 million copies as of March 2010 compared to *The Wall Street Journal's* 2.1 million, though this figure includes the WSJ's 400,000 paid-for, online subscribers.

USA Today remains the widest circulated print newspaper in the United States. *USA Today* is distributed in all fifty states, Canada, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam and the United Kingdom. The newspaper has its headquarters in Tysons Corner, unincorporated Fairfax County, Virginia. Currently, *USA Today* sells for US\$1.00 in newsstands; however, it is often found free at hotels and airports that distribute it to their customers.
