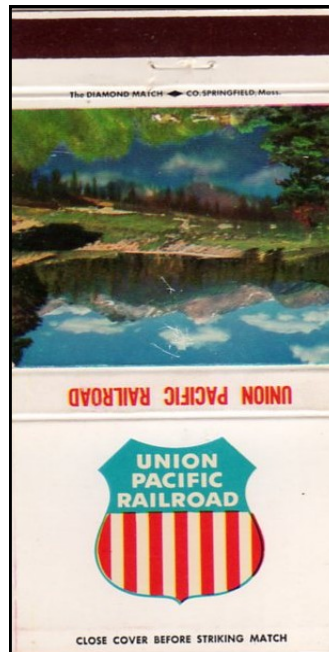


Definitely One Of The Nicer Sets...*Union Pacific*

There are literally *thousands* of sets available to the collector, running from three covers and up number-wise, and running the gamut as far as quality and attractiveness. Unfortunately for collectors today, it's a truism when you hear, "They just don't make 'em like that anymore." The great sets are from Yesteryear, and, there, the hobbyist has a dazzling variety to tempt his or her collecting pallet...and one of the nicest is from Union Pacific Railroad.

There are actually several similar sets to the one pictured here, utilizing the same theme...scenic spots along Union Pacific Railroad routes. Some of these sets were issued in 1956; others came out in 1957. Some of the sets were made up of 8 covers; one consisted of seven. Two of the sets were made by Universal; one was by Diamond.
