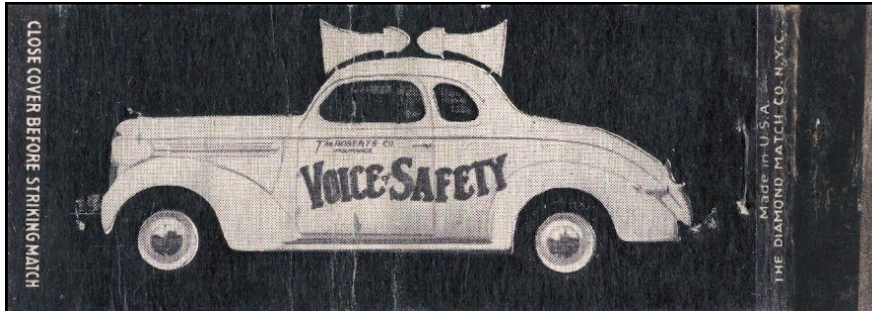


Featuring Full-Lengths!

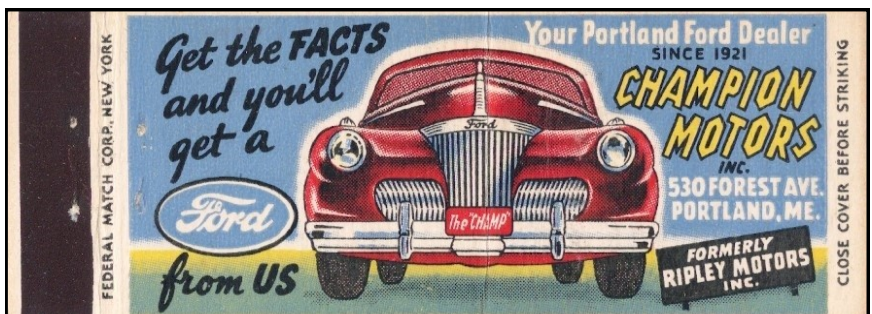
