Well, here are the results. I would have expected the IN FAVOR "Yes's" to be 100%. Why would a collector object to someone <u>else</u> having the option? I suspect those respondents misread the question. [Note: The "N/A" responses were those who didn't want the roster in any form]

**BUT**...I have since been informed by Linda that we already *HAVE* the e-mail roster option! It turns out that I e-mailed the current roster to some members in 2016, and I thought that was a one-time thing, but, no, it's permanently available to members. So, Linda won't be working on the 2019-2020 Roster until later in the year, but I'm making up the mailing list for the e-mail recipients now so it's ready to go when Linda and I need it.

Signing up means that you will be taken off the hard copy roster mailing list and receive the roster via e-mail. Also, please indicate the format you prefer (.doc, .xls, or .pdf.), and we'll do our best to accommodate you. (I actually can't open .xls files on my daily workhorse computer [I'm still using Windows XP], but I assume that if Linda sends me the roster in .xls I can still forward it to those who want it.)
