I collect state and national parks, and I don't believe there's another state that has issued more covers for its state parks than Kentucky...and why not?...The Kentucky State Park system boasts a total of 46 state parks including 17 full-service Kentucky resort parks (more than any other state).

Beyond the natural beauty and scenic views of the Kentucky landscape, Kentucky Resort Parks offer full -service lodges and fully-equipped cottages that include guest rooms and dining. Examples include Cumberland Falls State Resort Park, home of the rare "moonbow;" Kentucky Dam Village State Resort Park, located near the famous "Land Between the Lakes;" and Natural Bridge State Resort Park, near the Red River Gorge.

Kentucky's unique history and heritage is on display in Kentucky's Historic Parks. Explore frontierstyle pioneer forts, family mansions and Civil War sites. Learn about ancient cultures and artifacts at an excavated mound museum and travel down historic Native American trails.
