## Sorting Out The Tums Sets

They're attractive covers-colorful, animals, birds, etc., but if you happen to come across all of them it can be rather a daunting task to try and sort what goes where. There are multiple sets and variations. Indeed, while researching the topic, I found that some collectors were under the impression that these were 9 -cover sets, 12 -cover sets, etc., when, in fact, what we're dealing with here are 6 -cover sets. The late Jo Wilding had the original packaging of six.

All were issued by Universal in the early to mid-1950s, all are 20 -strikes, and, of course, all are frontstrikes. All have the same inside text, except as noted. As can be seen below, all three different types (Lures, Birds, and Wild Animals) have different front panel Tums designs, so all of these covers are not just the same design with a different picture on the back. Here's the guide:

Well, we originally calculated 15 different sets. Now, with Andre's and Carmine's input, we're up to at least 27 different sets, or 6 sets with 21 variations, and that's assuming that some of Carmine's variations that I've left out corresponded to the correct $\mathbf{A}$ or $\mathbf{B}$ insides noted by Andre. If they, in fact, don't, then we have even more variations. Within the first four sets (Lures and Birds), there are varying subsets ( 6 covers each), based on the inside text [see below]. The Wild Animals sets are labeled either Series \#1 or Series \#2.
