IH is now Case IH. Case bought IH in the 1980's. Then New Holland bought them out a few years ago. The company is called CNH which is Case New Holland.

Tom Gray, IA, had 114 stock designs with 1430 covers and 329 non-stock covers for a grand total of 1759 covers as of October 2013. Here's a breakdown:

Tractor and machinery covers. 20 strike covers=31 stock designs with 506 covers. 219 non-stock covers. 30strike covers = 4 stock designs with 101 covers. 14 non-stock covers. 40 strike covers= 13 stock designs with 237 covers. 21 non-stock covers.

Construction equipment covers. 20 strike covers. 7 stock designs with 25 covers. 9 non-stock covers. 30 strike covers = no stock designs. 21 non-stock covers. 40 strike covers = 4 stock designs with 42 covers. 13 non-stock covers.

Refrigerators/ freezers covers. 20 strike covers = 12 stock designs with 88 covers. 30 strike covers = 1 stock design with 1 cover. 40 strike covers = 5 stock designs with 25 covers.

Truck covers. 20 strike covers = 16 stock designs with 163 covers. 18 non-stock covers. 30 strike covers = 5 stock designs with 31 covers. 9 Non-stock covers. 40 strike covers = 16 stock designs with 211 covers. 5 non stock covers. [Covers courtesy of Loren Moore, CA]
