Lots of covers!	-7
Auctions!	-6
Friendships/Socializing	-6
More sophisticated collectors with serious collections and an interest in trading	-4
People that would welcome you and share knowledge and matches	-4
Freebie table!	-2
Free food!	-1
More people showing up!	-1
People actually doing something at the meeting	-1

Surprise! Most people go to meetings with the aim of obtaining covers! If you divy up the above results into 'getting covers' and 'other' responses, the results are even more obvious:

Getting covers: 23 Other: 9

If it was my responsibility to organize club meetings, I'd definitely focus on making lots of covers available to attendees. How do you do that? There are several venues: freebie tables (someone's got to donate covers), auctions, games (w/covers as prizes), trading (attendees need to bring trading material rather than excuses), dealer tables (the club, itself, could sell off covers it's accumulated), raffles and drawings.
