<p><b>Did you know?</b> <b>The Curtana</b></p> <p>This 17th century sword is the original sword of Order of the Garter. It is still used in the British Coronation to this day. The pattern sword carried before English monarchs as their coronation sword is historically considered the sword of mercy.</p> <p>Marketed by ITC LTD., 37, J.L. <p><b>Did you know?</b> <b>The Rapier</b></p> <p>Used for fencing in Europe, this sword was sometimes used as a left-handed dagger for added effectiveness. <p><b>Did you know?</b> <b>The Saber</b></p> <p>This was favoured by Chinese cavalry and foot soldiers because of its short and broad blade. <p><b>Did you know?</b> <b>The Cutlass</b></p> <p>This term came from "cutthroat" or "hugger" because it was a short, broad-bladed cutting sword.
